Title of calendar in Dari and Pashto language: “Window of Hope”

1. Picture of a Shopkeeper in Kabul

Photo text in the Afghan language Dari, “Blessed is the man who trusts in the Lord, and whose hope is in the Lord.” (Jeremiah 17:7)

Inset text in the Afghan language Pashto (next to the small photo of Panjshir Province, in blue-coloured box),

“If you keep your hope in God, he will not let go of your hands”

2. Picture of Sunrise in Kabul

Photo text, “Lord, be merciful to us, for we have placed our hope in you. Be our strength every morning, our salvation in times of trouble.” (Isaiah 33:2)

Inset text in Dari (next to the small picture of an arch in green-coloured box),

“You should never despair, there is always hope.”

(Psalms 33 : 22)

Inset text in Pashto (next to the small picture of a girl peeping out of a window, in beige-coloured box),

“Never worry about the uncertain future, everything is known to God. Trust God with all your heart, and He will show you which path is right for you”

6. *Picture a Girl and woman with burqa*

Photo text in Dari, “ ... But we also glory in our sufferings, because we know that suffering produces perseverance; perseverance, character, and character hope” (Romans 5:3-4)

Inset text in Pashto (next to the small photo of snowy mountain in Badakhshan Province, Afghanistan, in blue-coloured box),

“For I know the plans I have for you,” declares the Lord, “plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future.” (Jeremiah 29 :11)

7. *Picture of Winter season in one of the villages of Afghanistan*

Text in Pashto, “O God we follow all your commandments for all our hope is in you”

Inset text in Dari (next to the small photo of Snowy winter in Kabul, in gold-coloured box),

“I have a thousand hopes in you. You are the beginning of happiness and the end of waiting.”
